The Design Questionnaire is a great place to start. This form starts the process of putting your dreams down on paper in a manner that can be conveyed to others. Do not worry too much about getting too specific. That is what we are for. We will be here to provide support and to fill in the gaps.

After this is done, we start with the first draft of a plan. This may be hand drawn – bubbled as the Architects like to say. When the general layout is starting to take shape, then comes the actual first CAD draft of the plan.

The draft copy becomes a much reviewed piece of paper. It is only a floor plan. You take you copy home and study it. We do the same. Together we mull over the plan and discuss each room. We bring it together with changes and create the check set of plans with some final dimensions and the first draft of the exterior elevations. The process is starting to move to the next big hurdle. Creating the specifications. This is a very involved process we will discuss more in detail along with more forms to be provided.
